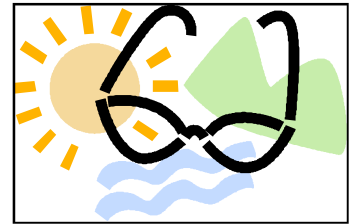

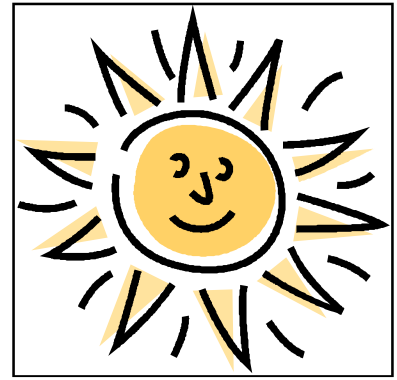
Guess Who Got the Job!
