CLASS DESCRIPTION: Supervised lab time devoted to the solving of accounting problems.

CLASS OBJECTIVES AND FORMAT OVERVIEW: The purpose of the lab is to provide the student with supervised time to work on solving the assigned bookkeeping problems for the AC170D class.
Each student is scheduled in a lab hour where a teacher or lab assistant is available to answer questions.

REQUIREMENTS: It is important for the student to attend and work on lessons each day in order to maintain satisfactory progress in the AC170D class.
