The Napa Superior Court Summer Internship Program offers law students a unique opportunity to build upon school experiences by observing how theoretical principles are put into actual practice. The program, designed primarily for students entering their second year of law school, includes in-court observations of actual proceedings, discussions with the judges and other principal players, as well as site visits with community partner agencies. Previous students have found these experiences increased their understanding of the legal system significantly as they gained real world understanding of how what they learned in school works. Students play an active part in the program and are encouraged to participate in various role plays as well as ask questions and offer comments throughout the program. Students may also participate in developing materials to assist self-represented litigants and members of the public, including other students, learn about the Napa Superior Court and legal processes.
