The Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco, is seeking third-year law students interested in unpaid legal externship assignments with the Court. These volunteer assignments may allow the extern to enhance their legal expertise and contribute in a meaningful way to the fair and efficient administration of justice in San Francisco. Legal Externs will be assigned in the Civil Division, Law and Motion Department, Office of the Presiding Judge, Criminal Division, or Unified Family Court, and will work directly with Judges, providing legal research, briefs and memos.

COMPENSATION: These are unpaid assignments in the Court.

FINAL FILING DATE: Résumés and writing samples will be accepted on an ongoing basis. However, early submission is encouraged since the Court may cease accepting applications when a suitable pool is achieved.

- A résumé, including related work experience and law school activities.
- A writing sample of not more than three pages in length.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Externs must be in their third year of law school with the anticipation of graduating from law school prior to June 30, 2010. Externs must be skilled in legal writing and research. For all positions, externs should be able to type, use computer equipment, and should be acquainted with the use of Lexis and Westlaw.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Résumés and writing samples received will be evaluated and the Court will select for interview only those externs it deems may best meet the needs of the Court.

Security Clearance: Externs selected to work for the Court will be subject to security clearance by fingerprinting.
